The University of Alabama School Social Work invites applications for renewable instructor positions to begin in August, 2012. These are nine month positions, with opportunities to teach in the summer sessions for additional compensation. These positions are not tenure-earning, but are renewable annually depending on need, funding, and performance.

An MSW and two post-masters years professional practice experience are required. Candidates with LCSW and previous teaching experience are preferred.

Applicants should be eager to teach in both the undergraduate and master's programs (four courses or the equivalent each semester) and have interest and expertise in reaching our diverse student body through online education. We are strongly invested in recruiting colleagues who demonstrate experience with, knowledge of, and sensitivity to the needs of culturally diverse and underrepresented populations.

The University of Alabama has an enrollment of more than 31,000 students on a residential campus located in Tuscaloosa, a metropolitan area with a population of approximately of 150,000 people. The community offers good neighborhood schools, low crime rates, and excellent recreational opportunities.
